TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

For Tube feeding:

Mix 20 grams of powder with 65 ml of hot water. Discard uneaten portions after 30 minutes

For Porridge feeding:

- Mix 50 grams of powder with 110 ml of hot water. Discard uneaten portions after 30 minutes
- Feeding amount needs to be adjusted based on your pet's body condition score and ability to consume
- Adjust accordingly to feeding guideline tables below

Important things to remember:



You may require more liquid than advised above for enteral feeding based on the size of your feeding tube



This is not a long term diet. Always advise your clients on the correct recommended feeding amounts



Flush tubes with water before and after feeding



When patients show signs of an improved appetite, slowly wean them back onto their regular diet
