



SOUTH AFRICAN VACCINE SCHEDULE

NOTE:

- The Rabies vaccine is a legal requirement for all dogs in South Africa.
- *High-risk areas for rabies include Limpopo, Mpumalanga, KwaZulu-Natal, Eastern Cape, Free State, and Lesotho. Be especially careful to comply with unique legal requirements in these areas.
- Some dog kennels will not accept dogs into their care without current, up-to-date vaccination certificates.

PUPPIES (4 WEEKS TO 1 YEAR)



4 WEEKS

DP (Distemper & Parvovirus, only for high-risk puppies)

6-8 WEEKS

1st puppy shot (DHPPi)

11-12 WEEKS

2nd puppy shot (DHPPi)

12 WEEKS

Rabies (Repeat 4 weeks later)

15-16 WEEKS

Rabies + 3rd puppy shot (DHPPi)

ADULT DOGS

DHPP: Annually

Parainfluenza: Annually

Rabies: Annually, depending on region

Bordetella (Kennel Cough): Annually when going to kennels

Leptospirosis: Annually
